Tournament Format

The tournament format will follow the previous tournament:

Minor Round

1 x 35 overs

T20 (games subject to number of teams being fielded per division)

Finals Round

Semi finals 3 v 4 – T 20 Grand Final 1 v 2 – 35 overs

Playing surfaces

It is intended to procure as many turf wickets as possible for all 3 divisions of the tournament. As soon as teams are lodged, we will be in a stronger position to know how many grounds we need.

Accessibility

Accessibility issues such as playing facilities, spectator facilities, car parking and public transport will be identified in due course.

UMPIRES

SAVCA is putting a call out for all teams who may wish to invite umpires from their local competitions to nominate for the SAVCA Women's Championships.
